HEARING SLATED TO REVIEW PESTICIDE BILL

For immediate release, Friday, July 16, 1993

WASHINGTON -- Continuing its review on federal pesticide policy, the House Agriculture Subcommittee on Department Operations and Nutrition has scheduled a hearing to review H.R. 1627, the "Food Quality Protection Act of 1993," announced Subcommittee Chairman Charles Stenholm, D-Texas.

The hearing will begin on Monday, August 2, at 1:00 p.m. in room 1300 of the Longworth House Office Building, Washington, D. C.

"We have had valuable and important hearings over the last couple of months," said Stenholm. "As we move the process forward in our ongoing effort to address this issue, it is important to review this legislation," he added.
