## REPRESENTATIVE KIKA DE LA GARZA ANNOUNCES FY 1994 HUD GRANTS FOR PUBLIC HOUSING MODERNIZATION IN 15th DISTRICT

For Immediate Release: 21 September 1994

WASHINGTON, DC -- South Texas Congressman Kika de la Garza today announced that more than \$4.1 million in grants for public housing modernization have been awarded to 22 Housing Authorities serving the 15th District through the US Department of Housing and Urban Development.

The Federal grant awards are part of the FY 1994 Comprehensive Improvement Assistance Program (CIAP) and will be used for projects including housing rehabilitation and modernization, work to bring housing into compliance, and lead-based paint abatement.

"These grant awards ensure that there will continue to be adequate public housing for the residents of the 15th District," Rep. de la Garza said.

The grant funding, whose release is subject to each Housing Authority's submission of an approvable budget and other required documents, includes:
