REPRESENTATIVE KIKA DE LA GARZA ANNOUNCES FY 1995
HUD GRANTS FOR PUBLIC HOUSING MODERNIZATION IN 15th DISTRICT

For Immediate Release: 1 September 1995

WASHINGTON, DC--South Texas Congressman Kika de la Garza today announced the award by the U S Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) of more than \$2.9 million in grants for public housing modernization to 22 Housing Authorities serving the 15th Congressional District.

The federal grant awards are part of the FY 1995 Comprehensive Improvements Assistance Program (CIAP) and will be used to improve the physical condition of existing public housing developments and to upgrade the management and operation of these developments to ensure that the developments continue to be available to serve low income families.

"These grant awards ensure that there will continue to be adequate public housing for the residents of the 15th District," Rep de la Garza said.

The grant funding, whose release is subject to each Housing Authority's submission of an approvable budget and other required documents, includes:
